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Dear Hillcrest Friends,

Thankfully, we have had a relatively quiet flu season so far. I hope most of you received the influenza (flu) vaccination discussed in last month's edition. We are going to shift gears to an important part of my practice, my focus on slowing down memory loss!

We now know that many of our baby boomers will reach their 90s, some even

100s. As we pass the age of 85, approximately 20% of all seniors will have some degree of dementia.

The risk of developing dementia, often referred to as memory loss, can be delayed or prevented with the proper health care adviser by your side. I have a special interest in helping our seniors live their best! Our later years can be golden!

As we strive for maintenance of brain health, we must pay attention to many risk factors that can **lead to** or even expedite dementia, such as uncontrolled diabetes, uncontrolled high blood pressure, elevated cholesterol, smoking, head trauma, and lack of exercise. Such risk factors should be addressed by your trusted clinician at regular intervals. Screening and treating the above will reduce risk of developing memory loss.

Another risk factor that is often overlooked is alcohol. Many of us believe that daily alcohol is good for us. A very recent multi-country trial has failed to show any benefit compared to risk of many health issues associated with alcohol, even one drink per day. Alcohol is a toxin affecting the brain as well as causing additional vitamin deficiencies that can worsen memory loss. I advise my seniors to avoid daily drinking and save alcohol only for special occasions.

In attending a recent Harvard conference on the health of seniors, I also learned the importance of social interactions and staying" busy". Many seniors retire and one to two years later lose memory and become dependent on others for many of their daily needs. Maintaining a productive day either via volunteer work, part time work, joining clubs, participating in art or music can help slow down brain decline in our senior years.

I cannot stress the importance of delaying retirement in the right individuals. This should be a discussion to have with your dedicated clinician. Since many of you will live into your 90s, retiring in your 60s will give you 30 years without work. Can you imagine 30 years being idle?! That is a third of many senior's life.

Just as important is hearing, so you better listen to this!! Even slight hearing loss can accelerate the rate of memory loss. No senior should lose any memory due to hearing loss.

Please get a hearing test at 65 and every 2-3 years after. Since the ears send messages to the brain, lack of hearing does not stimulate the brain and decline occurs. Same holds for vision since vision loss also reduces brain stimulation and over time leads to dementia.

To conclude, any type of employment or volunteer position can be very effective in keeping your brain as healthy as possible and can delay memory loss. Lowering other risk factors such as high blood pressure and cholesterol, smoking cessation, alcohol, exercise will all help my favorite seniors continue to enjoy their lives with a lesser chance of developing memory loss. Hearing and vision are also imperative to optimal brain health, so get screened. Give your brain the best protection against aging and developing memory loss.



They say that during sex, you burn off as many calories as running 8 miles...who the hell runs 8 miles in 30 seconds???



HAPPY NEW YEAR KITCHEN KORNER

Hate to cook but know someone who loves to? This is a great recipe but very labor intensive. However, it is PERFECT for Christmas Eve or anytime good seafood is in season. I would suggest that you buy the ingredients (yes, they are pricey) and give them to your friend who loves to cook. No matter what, anything made at home is cheaper than a restaurant and this one is worth it!

This year was the first time I have never made the traditional Italian



Christmas Eve Feast of the Seven Fishes stew . It is over the top delicious. You can substitute your favorite seafoods (Langostino, stone crabs, other types of fish) as long as you only use seven. I would like to think making this stew is like childbirth -next year I forget the pain of the labor and just remember the result.

FEAST OF THE SEVEN FISHES STEW

- even if you don't usually like anchovies, don't leave them out. They add just touch of briny salt flavor. Be sure you have all the ingredients prepped before you start cooking. Coincidentally there are SEVEN steps and the final result serves SEVEN people!

INGREDIENTS

- 1 TBS olive oil
- 1/2 lb. medium dry-packed scallops
- 1/2 lb. skinless salmon fillet, cut into 1" chunks
- $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. cod or other mild white fish cut into chunks
- 1/2 lb. peeled & deveined medium raw shrimp
- 1 oz. anchovies chopped and save the oil (most cans are 2 oz. so use $\frac{1}{2}$ can)
- $1\!\!/_2$ cup wine mixed with $1\!\!/_2$ cup water
- 12 clams (fresh or frozen)
- 1 lb. mussels (fresh or frozen)
- 1 medium fennel bulb, cored and sliced, save some fronds for garnish
- 4 chopped garlic cloves
- 1 tsp orange zest
- 28 oz. crushed tomatoes (open the can and add 1 tsp crushed red pepper)

DIRECTIONS

1. Let scallops, salmon ad fish come to room temperature. Heat oil in a large pot of medium-high. Add scallops and cook until one side is golden brown – about 2 minutes. Remove from pan and set aside.

2. Add wine-water mixture and clams to pan. Cover and turn heat on high until clams open, 5-7 minutes. Transfer clams to a bowl and discard any that don't open. Add mussels to pan and cook until they open, 3-4 minutes. Remove and set aside – discard any that don't open.

3. Pour all the liquid in the pot through a fine mesh strainer into a bowl and set aside.

4. Add the anchovy oil to the pan over medium-high. Add anchovies and cook until they dissolve; about 2 minutes. (Add a little olive oil if needed). Stir in the sliced fennel and cook for about 5 minutes, add the orange zest and cook for another minute.

5. Stir in reserved liquid, tomatoes and crushed red pepper. Reduce heat to medium and simmer uncovered for 12-15 minutes until the sauce is slightly thickened.

6. Gently add both fish and shrimp, cover and reduce heat to low. Cook for 6-8 minutes until seafood is opaque. Stir in the cooked scallops. At this point you may want to transfer the mixture to a heat-proof serving dish or crock pot set on low (or not). Top the stew with the clams and mussels facing up – it looks amazing! Garnish with fennel fronds and serve.

7. I made the dish four hours ahead of time and let it sit in the crock pot on low until an hour before and then turned it to warm. The longer Italian food sits the better it gets; and I had some time to relax before my guests arrived.

1.Asparagus and rhubarb. 2.Strawberry 3. Avocado. 4.It grew inside the bottle. The bottles are placed over pear buds when they are small and are wired in place on the tree. The bottle is left in place for the entire growing season. When the pears are ripe, they are snipped off at the stems.

In keeping with the tone of this issue, I thought you might enjoy a funny Real Estate story:

Rebuilding New Orleans after Katrina often caused residents to be challenged to prove home titles back hundreds of years. That is because of community history stretching back over two centuries during which houses were passed along through generations of family, sometimes making it quite difficult to establish a paper trail of ownership.

A New Orleans lawyer sought a FHA rebuilding loan for a client. He was told the loan would be granted upon submission of satisfactory proof of ownership of the parcel of property as it was being offered as collateral. It took the lawyer 3 months, but he was able to prove title to the property dating back to 1803. After sending the information to the FHA, he received the following reply.

(Actual reply from FHA): "Upon review of your letter adjoining your client's loan application, we note that the request is supported by an Abstract of Title. While we compliment the able manner in which you have prepared and presented the application, we must point out that you have only cleared title to the proposed collateral property back to 1803. Before final approval can be accorded, it will be necessary to clear the title back to its origin."

And here is the great letter the lawyer responded with: (Actual response): "Your letter regarding title in Case No.189156 has been

received. I note that you wish to have proof of title extended further than the 206 years already covered in the present application. I was unaware that any educated person in this country, particularly those working with real property, would not know that Louisiana was purchased by the United States from France in 1803, the year of origin of title identified in our application.

For the edification of uninformed FHA bureaucrats, the title to the land prior to U.S. ownership was obtained from France, which had acquired it by Right of Conquest from Spain. If every school principal gave this speech at the beginning of the next school year, America would be a better place.

To the students and faculty of our high school:

I would like to apprise you of some important changes coming to our school. I am making these changes because I am convinced that most of the ideas that have dominated public education in America have worked against you, against your teachers and against our country.

First, this school will no longer honor race or ethnicity. I could not care less if your racial makeup is black, brown, red, yellow or white. I could not care less if your origins are African, Latin American, Asian or European, or if your ancestors arrived here on the Mayflower or on slave ships.

The only identity I care about, the only one this school will recognize, is your individual identity — your character, your scholarship, your humanity. And the only national identity this school will care about is American. This is an American public school, and American public schools were created to make better Americans.

If you wish to affirm an ethnic, racial or religious identity through school, you will have to go elsewhere. We will end all ethnicity-, raceand non-American nationality-based celebrations. They undermine the motto of America, one of its three central values — e pluribus unum, "from many, one." And this school will be guided by America's values.

This includes all after-school clubs. I will not authorize clubs that divide students based on any identities. This includes race, language, religion, sexual orientation or whatever else may become in vogue in a society divided by political correctness.

Your clubs will be based on interests and passions, not blood, ethnic, racial or other physically defined ties. Those clubs just cultivate narcissism — an unhealthy preoccupation with the self — while the purpose of education is to get you to think beyond yourself. So, we will have clubs that transport you to the wonders and glories of art, music, astronomy, languages you do not already speak, carpentry and more. If the only extracurricular activities you can imagine being interesting in are those based on ethnic, racial or sexual identity, that means that little outside of yourself really interests you.


Second, I am uninterested in whether English is your native language. My only interest in terms of language is that you leave this school speaking and writing English as fluently as possible. The English language has united America's citizens for over 200 years, and it will unite us at this school. It is one of the indispensable reasons this country of immigrants has always come to be one country. And if you leave this school without excellent English language skills, I would be remiss in my duty to ensure that you will be prepared to successfully compete in the American job market. We will learn other language here — it is deplorable that most Americans only speak English — but if you want classes taught in your native language rather than in English, this is not your school.

Third, because I regard learning as a sacred endeavor, everything in this school will reflect learning's elevated status. This means, among other things, that you and your teachers will dress accordingly. Many people in our society dress more formally for Hollywood events than for church or school. These people have their priorities backward. Therefore, there will be a formal dress code at this school. Fourth, no obscene language will be tolerated anywhere on this school's property — whether in class, in the hallways or at athletic events. If you can't speak without using the f-word, you can't speak. By obscene language I mean the words banned by the Federal Communications Commission, plus epithets such as "Nigger," even when used by one black student to address another black, or "bitch," even when addressed by a girl to a girlfriend. It is my intent that by the time you leave this school, you will be among the few your age to instinctively distinguish between the elevated and the degraded, the holy and the obscene.

Fifth, we will end all self-esteem programs. In this school, self-esteem will be attained in only one way — the way people attained it until decided otherwise a generation ago — by earning it. One immediate consequence is that there will be one valedictorian, not eight.

Sixth, and last, I am reorienting the school toward academics and away from politics and propaganda. No more time will be devoted to scaring you about smoking and caffeine or terrifying you about sexual harassment or global warming. No more semesters will be devoted to condom wearing and teaching you to regard sexual relations as only or primarily a health issue. There will be no more attempts to convince you that you are a victim because you are not white, or not male, or not heterosexual or not Christian. We will have failed if any one of you graduates this school and does not consider him or herself inordinately lucky — to be alive and to be an American.

Now, please stand and join me in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of our country. If you do not know the words, consider learning them your first homework assignment.





All the suffering that goes on inside our minds is not reality, says Byron Katie. It's just a story we torture ourselves with. She has a simple, completely applicable system for freeing ourselves of the thoughts that make us suffer. "All war begins on paper," she explains. You write down your stressful thoughts, and then ask yourself the following four questions:

Question 1: Is it true?

This question can change your life. Be still and ask yourself if the thought you wrote down is true.

Question 2: Can you absolutely know it's true?

Question 3: How do you react—what happens—when you believe that thought?

Do you like to read a good murder mystery? Not even Law and Order would attempt to capture this mess. This is an unbelievable twist of fate!

Here is the story...

On March 23, 1994, the medical examiner viewed the body of Ronald Opus, and concluded that he died from a shotgun wound to the head. Mr. Opus had jumped from the top of a ten-story building intending to commit suicide. He left a note to that effect indicating his despondency.
